



The Waterford School is located on a 40-acre campus at the base of the Wasatch Mountains in Sandy, Utah, a suburb of Salt Lake City. The Waterford School ensures that your child will receive a challenging college preparatory, liberal arts education with Advanced Placement courses (17 AP courses offered), honors courses, fine arts, performing arts, and athletics.

Occasionally, Waterford will consider international students for admission. The school has an enrollment cap of 15 international students. The Waterford School does not offer an ESL program. International students must demonstrate a high level of English proficiency. It is recommended that international students seeking admission to Waterford School meet the following guidelines:

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSIONS GUIDELINES

1. The student must enroll no later than grade 10 and commit to enrollment through grade 12. Exceptions are made on occasion for well-qualified students interested in grade 11. We will not enroll an international student for just one year nor will international students be admitted to grade 12.
2. It is recommended that the student attend an accredited school in the U.S. for a minimum of one year prior to seeking admission to Waterford School. It is during this year of attendance that the student will complete a comprehensive ESL program.
3. The student will demonstrate a high level of English proficiency. To demonstrate English fluency, it is recommended that the student take the internet-based TOEFL exam, ideally attaining a minimum score of 85 on the internet-based TOEFL exam. The TOEFL Destination Code for Waterford School is 6454.
4. The student will meet all admissions requirements consistent with Waterford's academically rigorous program (see International Student Application Process).
5. Waterford does not make the arrangement for a host family. We prefer that the student reside with family or family friends who are committed to providing ongoing support necessary for a Waterford student's success.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATION PROCESS

- The application deadline for international students is June 15.
- Prior to the application deadline, parents should submit an online application for enrollment with a \$150.00 non-refundable application fee. Additional admissions forms requesting school records, teacher recommendation form(s), student essay form, and an international applicant supplement will be forwarded upon receipt of the initial application. - The student will complete the internet-based TOEFL exam and have that score sent directly from the testing center to Waterford School. Register for the iBT TOEFL test at <https://www.ets.org/toefl/ibt/register>
- Parents and students should visit the school. An on-campus interview is a required part of the admissions process. After the initial application and official TOEFL score is received, the Admissions Office will arrange this visit.

TUITION AND FEES

Tuition for international students is \$33,510 for the 2018-19 school year. Additional fees will be charged for books, materials, athletics, dining hall, and extracurricular activities. Discretionary items will be billed as they are incurred.
